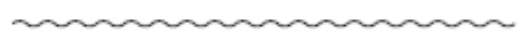
DID YOU KNOW?

A lot of people travel to work or home on water taxis and ferries (even in the wintertime!).

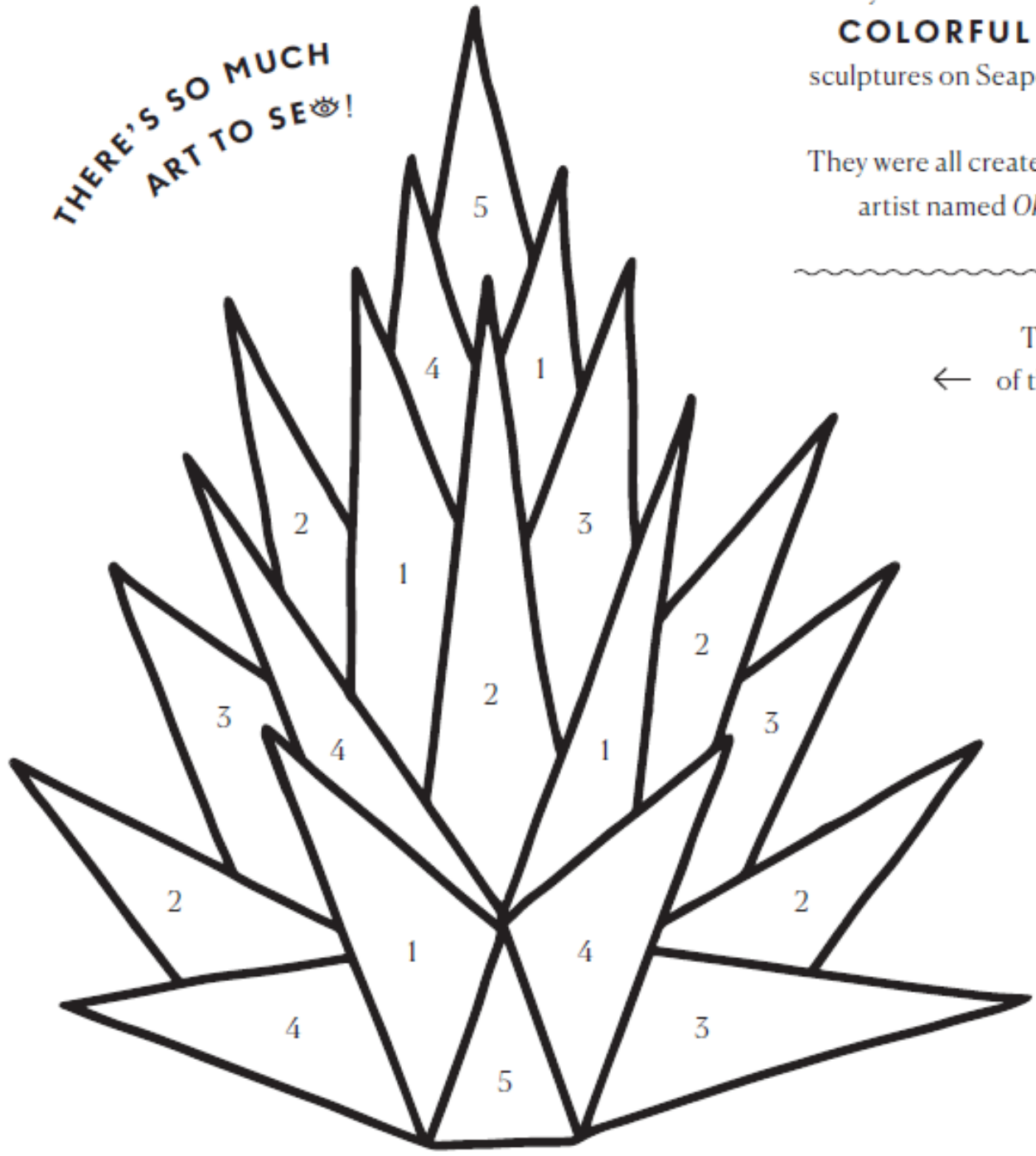
THERE'S SO MUCH
